


Hockey Hall of Fame Announces Full Rosters for Upcoming Legends Classic Game, **Highlighted by 84-Year-Old Terry Harper**

The annual Hyundai Hockey Hall of Fame Legends Classic highlights the Sunday afternoon schedule of the 2024 Induction Weekend Celebration. The event begins with a pre-game ceremony where each member of the 2024 Induction Class receives their official Honoured Member Blazer at centre ice. This is followed by a spirited hockey game featuring two star-laden teams consisting of HHOF Honoured Members, the incoming Induction Class, and former NHL and Olympic All-Stars.



While one can expect to see fan favourites and hometown heroes, including this year's captains, Jayna Hefford and Eric Lindros, there is one former NHLer who is making an extraordinary debut this year: Terry Harper, who reached out to the Hall to self enlist for the game.

Harper's accolades certainly fit the bill – a 19-year NHL playing career, 1,066 NHL games played and five Stanley Cup rings. However, what makes Harper a standout is that he is making his Legends Classic debut at 84 years of age! This easily makes him the oldest player to ever participate in the annual game.

Remarkedly, Terry will be 48 years senior to his linemate Wayne Simmonds. Don't let his age fool you though as Harper maintains a healthy, active lifestyle which has long consisted of playing twice a week in a competitive men's hockey league. And recently, he has doubled his ice time conditioning in preparation for his Legends Classic premier.








Terry Harper Quick Hitters:

- Born: January 27, 1940 in Regina, Saskatchewan
- Played in NHL from 1962 (when the NHL only consisted of 6 teams) to 1981 (19 years)
- Winner of 5 Stanley Cup rings with the Montreal Canadians ('65, '66, '68, (69, (71)
- Served as captain for the Los Angeles Kings and Detroit Red Wings
- Lives in sunny Los Angeles yet continues to play twice a week in men's league
