- ➤ At 9:55 p.m. sharp, the "Highest Bids" displays will be frozen and all registered participants will have an opportunity to make a *Final Bid* on any number of items (the computer will allow each participant only one *Final Bid* per item and will reject bids lower than the "Highest Bids" posted as of 9:55 p.m.).
